Advanced Mission Training exists to equip you to do these things. AMT combines bible courses with hands-on training and intends to produce missionaries who are fully equipped and can travel anywhere in the world for the gospel.

To get started with AMT your first step is to fill out an application and obtain a reference from your local pastor. After we receive the application form we'll contact you for a telephone interview. If selected, you will engage in a 12-week course that has been designed to be the most sought after Advanced Mission Training program in the world.
